1. NO LEAVER SHOULD VOTE LABOUR

Jeremy Corbyn's party has betrayed five million who voted to Leave the EU in 2016 and voted Labour at the last General Election. Corbyn's 2017 manifesto promised to respect the referendum result. Now Labour wants a rigged second referendum which would effectively offer us the choice between Remain and Remain. Labour is now the party of the metropolitan middle classes not the masses; the party of North London, not the North.

And it's not just that we can win in key seats this time — we must.

4. THE CONSERVATIVES STILL CAN'T BE TRUSTED TO DELIVER BREXIT ON THEIR OWN



DEMOCRATIC REFORM
